




additional income opportunities. The initiative highlights efforts to strengthen the goatery value chain by promoting cost-effective products, practices and diversified livelihood options.

🌿 A study on Effectiveness of Capacity Building & Training on Existing Fishery Cooperative Societies and Livelihood of Fishery Farmers in Telangana

BKSL is implementing 2 projects in Telangana under PMMSY and PM-MKSSY to strengthen 106 existing fishery cooperatives supported by SFAC. CLAP Foundation has conducted a study to assess the effectiveness of capacity building program on societies and also the impact on individual fishery farmers. The study report will help for further improvement of the capacity building program.



Awareness Program on Strengthening Fishery Cooperatives under PM-MKSSY, Mancherial, Telangana

BASIX Krishi has successfully conducted training and awareness sessions for fishery societies under PM-MKSSY in Mancherial district, Telangana aimed at strengthening the capacity of local stakeholders. The program focused on enhancing knowledge of different scheme components, implementation strategies and best practices in fisheries development. By selling directly to consumers, they ensure better price realization and maintain freshness and quality of fish. This approach reduces dependence on intermediaries, increases profit margins and strengthens the local fisheries economy. The cooperatives play a vital role in organizing members, streamlining supply and meeting local demand efficiently. Their efforts contribute to sustainable livelihoods, improved income stability and enhanced market access for small-scale fishers in the region.

Success Story:

“Bhuban Farmers Producer Company Limited, Odisha from Fields to Markets: A Transformational Journey of Farmer Empowerment”

Introduction:

Bhuban Farmers Producer Company Limited, established on 13th April 2021 under the Central Sector Scheme (CSS), stands as a remarkable example of farmer-led collective growth is promoted by BASIX Krishi Samruddhi Limited as CBBO and supported by Small Farmers' Agri-Business Consortium (SFAC) as IA in Bhuban block of Dhenkanal district, Odisha. Over a short span, it has mobilized more than 750 farmers across 40 villages, primarily small and marginal farmers, creating a strong institutional platform for agricultural development.

Background and Operational Landscape:

Agriculture is the primary livelihood for the farmers of Bhuban block, yet the region has long faced challenges such as poor infrastructure, fragmented landholdings, lack of aggregation and limited access to remunerative markets. Farmers traditionally depended on local traders, often resulting in low price realization and limited bargaining power.

The FPO deals with key commodities such as groundnut, paddy, millets, pulses and seasonal vegetables. It also plays an important role in promoting millet cultivation under government initiatives, contributing to nutritional security and climate-resilient agriculture.

Initial Challenges: A Difficult Beginning:

The initial phase of the FPO's journey was marked by significant challenges and hurdles. Farmer participation was low due to uncertainty about the benefits of collectivization. Financial constraints restricted the FPO's ability to deliver immediate services, while weak infrastructure and lack of organized market systems further limited its growth.

Additionally, during the post-pandemic period, disruptions in market channels led to reduced activity among local traders and collection agents, leaving farmers vulnerable to distress sales. These challenges tested the resilience of the FPO in its formative years.



Institutional Support and Turning Point:

The turning point came with proactive support from BASIX Krishi Samruddhi Limited (BKSL) as the CBBO. Through continuous handholding, capacity building and market facilitation, the FPO gradually strengthened its operations and farmer confidence. Even during COVID-19; the FPO procured watermelon from farmers ensuring 3 times higher price than local prevailing price and sold in the distance market like Jajpur.

Efforts to aggregate produce and establish market linkages resulted in the successful marketing of vegetables such as watermelon and pumpkin. This initial success demonstrated the benefits of collective marketing, encouraging more farmers to actively participate in the FPO.

Strategic Transformation: Building Market-Oriented Systems:

Over time, the FPO adopted a market-oriented approach, transitioning from a traditional farming collective to a business-driven enterprise. It established direct linkages with institutional buyers and leveraged digital platforms such as ONDC and e-NAM to ensure transparent pricing and wider market access.



The FPO also moved towards value addition by promoting millet-based food products, groundnut processing, and packaged agricultural produce. These initiatives enhanced product value and opened new income streams for farmers.

FPO has introduced Custom Hiring Centers to promote farm mechanization in its operational area with tractor, seed drill, sprayer machine, power tiller, mini processing unit etc.

Bhuban FPO has initiated a Groundnut Seed Multiplication Program with support from the Directorate of Groundnut Research (NRCG), Junagadh, Gujarat. This initiative aims to strengthen the groundnut value chain cluster by enhancing seed quality, improving productivity, and ensuring better market opportunities for farmers.



Strengthening Farmer Services and Capacity Building:

A key focus area of the FPO has been strengthening farmer services. It provides access to quality seeds, fertilizers, farm equipment, storage facilities, and logistics support. In addition, advisory services and extension activities have been instrumental in improving farm productivity.

Regular training programs, field demonstrations, and peer learning initiatives have enabled farmers to adopt scientific agricultural practices. Crop diversification, particularly the promotion of pulses and millets alongside paddy, has improved soil health and increased income opportunities.

Growth and Business Performance:

The FPO has demonstrated steady and consistent growth since its inception. It has shown steady financial growth with turnover increasing from Rs. 36.3 lakh in FY 2021-22 to Rs. 77.5 lakh in FY 2024-25, alongside a consistent rise in net profit. Overall, it has generated business exceeding Rs. 2 crores, reflecting strong performance and growing farmer participation.

Membership has expanded significantly and the FPO now serves as a reliable platform for aggregation, marketing and service delivery. This growth reflects the increasing trust of farmers in the collective model and the effectiveness of its business strategies.

Impact at Scale: Transforming Farmer Livelihoods:

The interventions of the FPO have led to tangible improvements in farmer livelihoods. Collective marketing has enhanced price realization, while multiple market channels have increased farmers' bargaining power. Reduced input costs and improved access to services have further strengthened farm economics.

Farmers are now better informed about market trends and have the flexibility to choose buyers offering competitive prices. The adoption of improved farming practices has increased productivity, while crop diversification has reduced risks associated with mono-cropping.

Importantly, the FPO has helped farmers avoid distress sales by ensuring assured market linkages and timely aggregation of produce.



🏆 Governance and Community Participation:

The active involvement of the Board of Directors has been a key driver of the FPO's success. With strong institutional support, governance systems have improved, leading to better decision-making and operational efficiency.

Membership has grown from a small base to over 750 farmers, reflecting increased trust and engagement within the farming community. The FPO has also fostered a culture of collaboration, knowledge sharing, and collective responsibility among its members.

🏆 Recognition and Achievements:
